ISMPP Certification Board Overview

The ISMPP Certification Board oversees and supervises the ISMPP CMPP™ Certification Program. The Certification Board serves as an independent and autonomous body within ISMPP to develop, evaluate, supervise, and administer all Certification Program policies, procedures, and activities. ISMPP Certification Board Composition

The Certification Board includes at least five (5) qualified voting Directors elected by the ISMPP Certification Program (CMPPs in good standing). All elected and appointed positions are two-year terms.

ISMPP Certification Board Positions and Qualifications

There are two (2) open voting Director seats on the ISMPP Certification Board. The officers of the Certification Board (Chair, Vice-Chair, and Secretary) will be elected from among the voting Directors once the Board is established.

Commitment

If you are considering running for a position, please note that the Certification Board meets via teleconference once per month and attendance at infrequent ad-hoc meetings may also be required. Additionally, Certification Board members must be able to commit up to approximately 5 hours per month for duties that accompany the position. Members also may not continue activity on another ISMPP Committee or Board if elected (due to time commitment required) without prior discussion with the Certification Board.

Eligibility for Nomination*

For the Certification Board positions, the *minimum* requirements for each candidate include:

- Must be a CMPP in good standing
- Must be considered a subject matter expert by members of the Nominations Committee
- Candidates will be ranked higher for each of the following:
 - Prior, active service on a CMPP Committee (eg, Recertification, Newsletter, etc)
 - Prior, active service on an ISMPP Committee
 - Prior participation in an ISMPP educational activity, including the development or presentation of a session at an ISMPP meeting (Annual, EU, Academy, etc), an ISMPP workshop, or ISMPP U webinar
 - Verifiable leadership experience in one or more of the following areas: publication planning, credentialing, non-profit governance, finance, or business development
- Ability to attend ISMPP Annual (or other regional) Meeting preferred but not required

****The ISMPP Certification Board Nominations Committee will have sole discretion to put forth the most qualified candidates.***

The Certification Board Candidate Nomination Form includes:

- Personal details, including relevant experience
- Brief bio (200-word maximum)
- Statement on why you are qualified to serve (200-word maximum)
- Professional references (2 preferred; provide name, email address, and phone number)

- The first meeting of the new Certification Board will occur in August 2026
