

Accessibility Checklist

Posters

- ✓ Larger images and text
- ✓ Reduce visual clutter
- ✓ Plain language
- ✓ Clear structure and reading order
- ✓ Include links to the audio summary and online version of the poster
- ✓ Use high color contrast between text and background
- ✓ Use clear labeling to distinguish groups instead of relying solely on color

Oral Presentations

- ✓ Slides available in advance
- ✓ Recording available after the talk
- ✓ Accurate captions or transcript
- ✓ Provide verbal explanations of images
- ✓ Balance larger images with enough text to help the audience follow along

Conference Spaces

- ✓ Provide quality virtual options
- ✓ Wider spaces between posters and improved mobility access
- ✓ More seating and quiet spaces
- ✓ Better acoustics
- ✓ Provide microphones for presenters and audience questions
- ✓ Large signage, braille options
- ✓ Build in accessibility from the beginning, not the last minute
